 1. Purchase Your Materials Necessary 2"x12" Piece of Wood Minwax Stain (Jacobean) Miniwax Polyurethane Foam Brushes L Shelf Brackets Optional Sand Paper (just to clean up the wood a bit if there are rough edges) Clean, Dry Cloth (used to wipe excess stain from wood) Painter's Pyramid Stands (well worth the small cost) Gloves (optional to protect your hands when staining) Rustoleum Spray Paint (optional if you choose to spray paint your own) HomeRight Spray Shelter (only if you end up buying metal L brackets from the hardware store and spray painting them) Circular Saw (only needed if you buy your wood from a place that doesn't cut it for you - Home Depot cut mine to size in store) Multipurpose Laser Level See post for affiliate links to purchase any of my recommended items above
☐ 2. Cut wood to size, if needed
☐ 3. Lightly sand the wood
4. Stain all sides of the wood shelves
☐ 5. Spray brackets, if needed
☐ 6. Apply clear coat to the wood shelves
